 - Typical behavior difficulties that occur at home and at school
- Principles behind an Effective Behavior Plan and individualized behavioral planning

Dr. Stember holds a Ph.D. in clinical psychology and completed his clinical internship and post-doctoral training at Harvard Medical School/McLean Hospital. Dr. Stember currently maintains appointments at both Harvard and McLean, and was previously the Director of Behavioral Medicine at North Shore Children's Hospital. He specializes in cognitive behavioral therapy for children, adults and families at his Arlington and Salem offices. He consults to the Landmark School, Dover-Sherborn Regional Schools and Ipswich Public Schools, to name a few. He has given multiple grand round presentations, and continues to train educators, administrators and mental health providers on the applications of these treatments in the classroom setting. Dr. Stember is perhaps best known for his charismatic approach to staff training and treatment.
